

Fees, scholarships & financing



At ESCP we believe in equal opportunities. That is why we have created a scholarship programme that encourages social diversity and values individual commitment.

Scholarships can cover 10% to 50% of tuition fees (excluding firstyear registration fee) and are assigned based on different criteria such as merit, diversity and financial needs. They are renewable each year on condition of academic achievement, behaviour and involvement in the ESCP community.

CROUS scholarship holders:

Students who are eligible for CROUS scholarships allocated by the French Ministry of Higher Education are eligible for an ESCP need based scholarship. The exemption percentage ranges from 10% to 50% depending on CROUS level.

Bank Loan

Many banks offer student loans at attractive rates, with deferred payback. Recent ESCP students have received interest rates as low as 1%. Consult your bank for information on a personal loan.

Furthermore, thanks to a partnership with BNP Paribas, the ESCP Foundation Endowment Fund supports students who encounter difficulties to obtain student credit in the absence of a solid guarantor (please note that this is currently only available for French students).





Business Games

Business Games are online simulations played by teams of students in order to compete in a virtual business environment. An exciting and relevant exercise, the aim is to introduce you to the complexity of business decision-making. Each team must make decisions relating to areas such as finance, marketing and operations. The best-performing team wins the game and each team has the possibility to further their experience by participating in international competitions (e.g. Solvay Business Game and L'Oreal Brandstorm).

Collective Projects

Collective Projects offer students an opportunity to contribute to the life of their programme and campus whilst acquiring practical managerial and leadership skills. At the beginning of each of your first two academic years, you will work in small teams to identify and plan the development of a project for the rest of the academic year. Projects can be varied in terms of their focus, and may be linked with careers, social life, humanitarian aid or be more business/ digital oriented. Students are encouraged to be creative.

Work and Study Track

Students studying in Paris in their final year will be on a work and study track. Half of their time will be spent attending academic classes at ESCP Paris Campus and the other half working within a company based in Paris. This allows students to deepen their experience in the corporate world while completing their studies.

Students on the work and study track that are not French native speakers must demonstrate a minimum of a C1 level in French.

























Promoting an Entrepreneurial Spirit



STEP 2 Personal interview

If your initial application is successful, you will be invited to attend an oral interview with at least two people, including faculty members.

The interview is designed to assess your motivation, the match between your profile and your curriculum, and your personality (adaptability, maturity, openness to an international experience, etc.).

Whilst we prefer to meet students in person, distance interviews are a perfectly viable option.

STEP 3 Admission results

The School will send you the admission results and, if you are admitted, you will be offered:

- · A place (unconditional or conditional) on the programme with a deadline by which to
- · Your study track for the first two years. The third campus will be determined later as it depends on your choice of specialisation.

In order to confirm your enrolment, you will need to pay a deposit of €2,500, that will be deducted from the enrollment fee.

A VISA is what allows you to enter the country where you will be studying. It is recommended that you begin the visa process as soon as you receive your high school diploma.
