## Fees, scholarships & financing



At ESCP we believe in equal opportunities. That is why we have created a scholarship programme that encourages social diversity and values individual commitment.

Scholarships can cover 10% to 50% of tuition fees (excluding first-year registration fee and service fee) and are assigned based on different criteria such as merit, diversity and financial needs. Financial needs scholarships are renewable each year on condition of academic achievement, behaviour and involvement in the ESCP community.

#### CROUS scholarship holders:

Students who are eligible for CROUS scholarships allocated by the French Ministry of Higher Education are eligible for an ESCP need based scholarship. The exemption percentage ranges from 10% to 50% depending on CROUS level.

#### **Bank Loan**

Many banks offer student loans at attractive rates, with deferred payback. Recent ESCP students have received interest rates as low as 1%. Consult your bank for information on a personal loan.

Furthermore, thanks to a partnership with BNP Paribas, the ESCP Foundation Endowment Fund supports students who encounter difficulties to obtain student credit in the absence of a solid guarantor (please note that this is currently only available for French students).



## City of Turin



Students on the work and study track that are not French native speakers must demonstrate a minimum of a C1 level in French.





## STEP 2 Personal interview

If your initial application is successful, you will be invited to attend an online interview with at least two people, including faculty members.

The interview is designed to assess your motivation, the match between your profile and your curriculum, and your personality (adaptability, maturity, openness to an international experience, etc.).

## STEP 3 Admission results

The School will send you the admission results and, if you are admitted, you will be offered:

- · A place (unconditional or conditional) on the programme with a deadline by which to
- · Your study track for the first two years. The third campus will be determined later as it depends on your choice of major.

In order to confirm your enrolment, you will need to pay a deposit of €2,500, that will be deducted from the enrolment fee.

A VISA is what allows you to enter the country where you will be studying. It is recommended that you begin the visa process as soon as you receive your high school diploma.
